





ISSA's Approach to the Ukraine Response



ISSA's network mechanism and functions

As a network and a membership association, ISSA's response to the crisis created by the war in Ukraine is focusing primarily on the following **network mechanisms**:

ISSA's Streams of Action translated into practice

Principles of action:

Strategic positioning:

- ISSA Members as key ECD players and experts at country level
- ISSA Network as a platform for scaling up responsive programs/solutions and for learning across countries
- ISSA Network as a strategic regional player

Strategic program intervention:

- Meet the Members' needs at country level
- Build expertise in the network to lead country work
- Use existing key expertise in the network for scaling-up quality, inclusive and responsive services
- Coordinate program interventions at cross-country and country level to ensure coherence and amplified impact on a medium and long term at country level.

Strategic fundraising:

- 75% funds towards members for country implementation
- 25% funds for ISSA Secretariat for network mechanisms and support; ToTs; reporting; coordination.
- Ensure the distribution of funds and coordination of funding sources across member and fill the funding gaps for meaningful impact at country level, considering other funding available locally.

Strategic partnerships:

- Engage with global/regional partners from whom we can learn and with whom we can have greater impact via synergy
- Enable beneficial partnerships for Members at country level.

Primary target countries: Bulgaria, Hungary, Latvia, Moldova, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Ukraine (other countries added as needed)
